WHAT IS AN ADVANCED WORKSHOP?

It's an experiential place, where we invite you to learn in the framework of specific topic. It's a short, but impressive dive into learning.

Participation is suited for those who are interested in experiential learning within a group context. In particular the workshop is intended for those who experience group dynamics are a basic tool in the individual learning process.

The Group as Participant- the implications for the role, position and tasks of a facilitator in working with groups.

This workshop will look at different group phenomena, their influence on the individual group members and their practical implications for us as facilitators or therapists.

- What is the impact of a developing group on our position as facilitator?
- How can we influence this development?
- What are different system levels and what is the effect of placing interventions at a certain level?
- How are norms and roles being established within groups and what is our role in that?
- How can they help or hinder the development of the group and what does the different roles tell us about the theme's being present in the group

WHAT TO EXPECT?

Theory will be provided, participants' knowledge and experience will be tapped and the actual 'being present' in the workshop group and at the conference' will be used.

At the end of the workshop session, participants will have an answer on the above raised questions and will have plenty more questions to think about.

They will have gained a raised awareness of how these mechanisms play a role in here-and-now situations.

He holds a master in educational sciences and is a Gestalt and person-centred therapist with specialisations in Existential and in Group Psychotherapy. He was the co-founder of a European Challenge Course Construction and Training Company.

He is co-chair of the Adventure Therapy International Committee, presented at several international conferences and is the author of a number of articles.
